****Your Costume and Props****

- Good walking sneakers
- Extra spending money
- Towels, face-clothes and optional flip-flops for the shower
- Shampoo, soap etc.
- An optional light Blanket and/or pillow for traveling etc.
- All other basic travel apparel (Clothing for 3 days, toothbrush & paste, ...)
- Water bottle
- Lanyard for keys

Please note:

- Electronics are acceptable to bring, but are not allowed in the theatres during plays. You must pay special attention not to lose your device since we will not interrupt our time at the festival, looking for lost phones etc.
- **PLEASE KEEP PACKING LIGHT!** We must take 40 people and their luggage on one bus and packing the bus can prove to be very challenging. If possible, bring softer gym-like bags, since they fit under the seats much easier.

We will be loading the bus at 8:20am Monday morning. Please meet in the gym and be ready to roll for that time. We will return between 8:30 and 9pm on Wednesday.
