<p>Read a book and find 3 sight words in it.</p>	<p>Write down one sight word. Find 3 words that rhyme with the first word and write them down too.</p> <p>Example: at hat, bat, sat</p>	<p>Rainbow Write</p> <p>Write a sight word, trace it over and over with different colors.</p>
<p>First, have someone in your house write sight words on paper and place them around your house.</p> <p>Then, find the sight words and read them out loud.</p>	<p>Write a sentence using at least 2 sight words.</p> <p>Draw a picture that goes with your sentence.</p>	<p>First, have someone in your house write sight words on paper and place them around your house.</p> <p>Then, go around your house with paper and a pencil and write down the words you find.</p>
