Word Problems for May 19 - May 22

- 1. Mr. McGregor wants to put a rectangular fence around his carrots to keep Peter Rabbit out. If the length of his garden is 20 m and the width of his garden is 10 m, how much fencing will he need to buy?
- 2. Little Sally buys 16 m of fencing to put around her square flower bed. What is the length and width of Sally's flower bed?
- 3. Farmer Bill has 24 metres of fencing. How many different rectangular chicken coops can he make?
- 4. Susie is going to make one wall in her bedroom a chalkboard wall. If the wall is 3 m high from floor to ceiling and 5 m wide, how many litres will she need to buy? (One litre of chalkboard paint covers 4 square metres.)
