

Word Problems for May 19 – May 22

1. Mr. McGregor wants to put a rectangular fence around his carrots to keep Peter Rabbit out. If the length of his garden is 20 m and the width of his garden is 10 m, how much fencing will he need to buy?
2. Little Sally buys 16 m of fencing to put around her square flower bed. What is the length and width of Sally's flower bed?
3. Farmer Bill has 24 metres of fencing. How many different rectangular chicken coops can he make?
4. Susie is going to make one wall in her bedroom a chalkboard wall. If the wall is 3 m high from floor to ceiling and 5 m wide, how many litres will she need to buy? (One litre of chalkboard paint covers 4 square metres.)
