
#### Notes:

# Writing and Representing

- If you haven't already done so, brainstorm a list of Remembrance Day words, sights, sounds, thoughts, feelings
- Step 1 of Memoir/Personal Narrative: do a web brainstorm (or a list) of ideas for your memory such as who, what, when, where, why, how, sights, sounds, feelings, tastes, smells of your memory
- Step 2 of Memoir/Personal Narrative: write a hook or interesting first sentence
  of your memory by looking at 1<sup>st</sup> sentences from 4-5 books for ideas and write
  your first paragraph by writing about who, what, when, where, why of your
