



Dear Parents,

Congratulations to your child! They have been selected to take part in this season's MAA Drama production of "The Day the Internet Died". We were able to take on 32 young thespians for this play and we are very happy that your child has earned the privilege to participate.

Our play will be featured in this year's NBTA Provincial Drama Festival in Fredericton. This means that on Monday, May 8th we will be taking a two-night trip to the provincial capital. We will return late Wednesday night (9pm). These three days will be very exciting and at the same time educational (shhh...don't tell the actors! 😊). We will be taking in plays, workshops, award ceremonies and we will be performing our own play as well. We are hoping to perform in the Black Box Theatre, on Tuesday of the Festival. Approximate costs that we need for you to cover include: (Note: This is based on previous years- I will update as soon as new numbers are made available)

- \$20 student registration;
- \$50 for accommodations at STU;
- \$96 dollars for 8 meals (which we will collect before leaving & distribute \$12 at each meal);
- \$15 T-shirt

The total for the 3-day venture will be **\$181**. This does not include spending \$ and extra money for snacks or larger meals etc.

Please note: We will be selling tickets on a Mother's Day basket to offset these costs. Students can sell tickets up to and beyond the required \$181 for Drama Fest. See the back of this notice.

The school has agreed to pay busing (approx \$1000), play registration, scripts, royalties, music, supply teachers and many other miscellaneous costs. **We will also need your help finding a costume for your child's character.**

Drama will be an important commitment for your child, and they are expected to come to each rehearsal. We will try to give them/you as much notice as possible when it comes to practice and pick-up times. **Please check the MAA Website for our link and scheduled rehearsal times, <http://maa.nbed.nb.ca/clubs/maa-drama-club-6-8>.** As we get closer to the festival, more rehearsal times will be added.

We are looking forward to another very successful year of drama and we are elated to have such a dynamic cast and crew. This will be an invaluable experience for your child, and we thank you so very much for your support. We will be performing the plays for the public at home after the festival, for your viewing pleasure.
