## An example of what a day of Home Learning could look like:

9:00am	French literacy activities posted on my teacher page.  - At least 15min. of reading activities (Keep your work in your homework folder) (Make sure you have your name and date on all work)
9:45am	RECESS BREAK (Move your body, have a snack)
10:00am	Online learning (if you have access, links on teacher page)  Lalilo Boukili Zorbits
11:00am	LUNCH BREAK (Have a healthy lunch)
12:00pm	Physical Education/Art/Music
1:00pm	Math assignments posted on my teacher page.  (Keep your work in your homework folder)  (Make sure you have your name and date on all work)
2:00pm	English reading

<sup>\*</sup> This is just an example of how you could space out your day. These activities don't all take this much time, but sometimes it helps to have a set time for when you will start a new task.

If you are in daycare or with a sitter throughout the day and cannot do any school work there, you should try to fit in 30 minutes for French literacy assignments and 30 minutes for Math assignments in the evening.
