<p>No Technology Suggestions</p>	<p>Grab a book and read for 20 minutes!</p>	<p>Begin a writing journal. It could be as simple as writing about what you are doing each day. Try to write for 15 minutes. Include a drawing as well. It's your journal, so have fun with it!</p> <p>Write your teacher a letter. They would love to hear from you.</p>	<p>Play a board game such as Snakes & Ladders, Sorry, Trouble, Monopoly or Yahtzee.</p> <p>Playing board games helps children develop many numeracy skills such as subitizing (knowing how many in a set without counting), adding, counting, understanding the concepts of before and after, taking turns, following rules/instructions.</p> <p>Card and dice games such as War, Go Fish, and Crazy 8s all work!</p>	<p>Start a jar of wishes. Each time you wish you could do something that social isolation won't allow you to do, get a piece of paper and write it down. Then put it in the jar. When we are no longer isolated look at your wishes and do those things.</p> <p>Get active for at least 15 minutes per day.</p>	<p>French Literacy Grab a French book and read for 20 minutes.</p> <p>Writing/Écriture Students may choose activities such as a daily journal.</p> <p>Mathematics Students may choose activities like the English games listed, but in French.</p>
