#### **Meet Format-**

In each school packet there will be a meet tally sheet and a school race tally sheet. After each race the runners are asked to go to their coach who will then record any of the top 10 finishers from their school on the meet tally sheet. At the end of the meet coaches are asked to pass in the meet tally sheet for their school to the meet coordinator. The school race tally sheets are for the schools to use to record their results for their own runners.

- There will be six races unless there is a low number of participants in a particular grade, there could be a combined race.( Girls – Grade 3-4-5 and Boys - Grade 3-4-5)
- Races are approximately 1 Km (\*\*\*\*Note: Host schools will need volunteer spotters on the trail and also people to take registrations/hand out coach packages and to hand out ribbons at the end of the race.)
- Individual - Ribbons will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 10<sup>th</sup> place for each race. The top 3 finishers from each school for each race will also receive a ribbon (these ribbons will be in your school packet)
- School Champions - there will be a banner presented to the school that wins the point total at the end of the 4 meets. For every race the top 5 finishers will count for points with 1st place receiving 5 points, 2nd 4 points, 3rd 3 points etc.
- The cost for each school is \$50 for the season. Please make cheques payable to Miramichi Valley High School. These funds will be used to purchase the ribbons, trophy and any other materials that are required for the meets.
- Schools will be expected to assist with tabulation of results (1 person/school)
